Surface preparation

Ensure all surfaces are dry, clean and free form dirt, oil, grease and contamination.

Internal Non Porous Substrates: eg. Previously painted, ceramic etc apply 1 coat of Blackfriars Problem Solving Primer (Note: if existing coating is hard/glossy then abrade before application).

Internal Porous Substrates: eg. plaster, wood, MDF etc seal with 1 coat Blackfriars Problem Solving Primer.

Radiator: apply 1 coat of Blackfriars Problem Solving Primer (Note: existing coating should be abraded before application). The metallic finish should be protected by one or two coats of Blackfriar Duratough Clear Varnish.

Internal Ferrous Metal: eg. cast iron, steel, apply a suitable anti corrosive primer.

Other Non Ferrous Metals: apply 1 coat Blackfriars Problem Solving Primer. Galvanised metal should be treated with a mordant solution prior to application of a primer.

limitations

If the Metallic Paint is to be sprayed, ensure that a "wet coating" is applied to the substrate. Care should be taken to avoid dry spraying as this may impair the final dry film appearance.

safety precautions

A copy of the appropriate Health & Safety Data Sheet should be consulted prior to using the product. This can be faxed if urgently required.

Minimum precautions for all paints:

- 1. Avoid skin and eye contact i.e. wear gloves, goggles, etc
